Please find below important information regarding our upcoming school journey to the Little Canada PGL Activity Centre on the Isle of Wight.

Departure

Please assemble in the school hall on **Monday 20th May at 7:00am** with a packed lunch (no glass bottles or nut products) and plenty of drink. Due to ferry crossing times, it is essential that all pupils arrive on time so that the coach can leave promptly.

Medical forms and medication

It is essential that medical forms are completed for each child and handed into the school office by **Friday 3rd May**. Please speak to Miss Lisa if you have any issues with completing the form.

All prescribed medication must be clearly labelled with your child's name and instructions for dosage. Please hand all prescribed medication/forms, including inhalers and Epi-Pens to Mrs Smart on Monday morning.

Kit list

The children should have a packed, medium-sized suitcase/holdall with them, which they can carry. Please see kit list attached outlining items they should bring. The children will also need to bring a **sleeping bag** and **pillow** with them. Children should keep hold of their pillow and carry it alongside their packed lunch on the coach if it isn't attached to their bag. They also need to bring one 'disco outfit' for Thursday evening.

As we are travelling to an outdoor activity centre, the children are permitted to wear their own clothes and leavers' hoody to travel in.

Please note that children should **not** bring electronic items such as mobile phones to PGL.

Pocket Money

PGL presents a rare opportunity for the children to bring pocket money on a school trip! Please arrange for £15 (maximum) in pound coins to be handed in at the office to Miss Lisa as soon as possible.
