



## **Year 5 Residential Camping Trip - Final Arrangements**

Please take note of the following arrangements:

**All children need to come to the school hall by 8.50am on Monday morning. They do not need to wear their school uniform.**

**Your child will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of drink to have when we arrive on camp.**

### **MEDICATION**

If your child is going to be on medication during their stay at camp, please hand this in to Mrs Stevens-Cox on the morning of our departure. Completed medical forms should now have been handed in to Miss Lisa.

Please ensure that your child's medicine is **clearly labelled** with child's name and dosage and that you have filled in a '**Prescribed Medicine Form**' before we leave.

We will be staying at The St John Bosco Centre, Halstead Road, Colchester, CO6 3PH.

**YOUR CHILD WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING  
ITEMS TO CAMP:**

**Essential Items:**

- Sleeping bag / pillow
- Waterproof jacket
- Shorts
- Sun hat
- Plenty of old clothes
- Trainers / wellies / crocs
- Torch (with batteries!) or a rechargeable one
- Wash kit
- Bath towel
- Swimming trunks / costume
- Pyjamas (Corpus Christi tracksuit would be perfect)

**Please also include the following:**

- Plenty of underwear and spare socks
- T-shirts that cover the shoulders
- Fleece or warm jumper to wear in the evening / night
- Woolly hat to wear if it gets cold
- Sandals with straps (if you have them)
- An air tight container with a small supply of sweets / goodies
- £10-£15 pocket money, to be kept in a wallet or purse
- A teddy or soft toy for night time
- Some plastic bags for dirty clothes
